

BYLAWS CHANGES 2019-20 SEASON

1) D5. PLAYING HOURS - VARIATION

Add clause to D5. (b) – add following sentence

Any match commencing after the above cut off time of will result in the match result overturned as per bylaw A4.

2) C5. (2) QUALIFICATIONS FOR SEMI-FINAL AND FINAL (JUNIOR) MATCHES

Add Section C5 (2) – Stipulate finals qualifications for junior section

1. No player is qualified to play in Finals unless the player has played at least 25% of matches played in the respective competitions. Forfeits or abandoned matches cannot be used to meet the above qualification standard.
2. A player shall not be eligible to play in Finals if they have not met criteria (1), and subject to section (3), cannot play in a lower team or competition unless at least 50% of the matches played, in which the player has participated, were in the lower teams or in the lower competition.
3. Where a club has more than one team in a particular grade they shall be rated by the association prior to the commencement of the season as to which shall be deemed the higher ranked team for the purpose of this bylaw. Any transfer of players between these teams during the finals will therefore be subject to sections of bylaw C5 (1) clauses 5,6,7,8 and 11.
4. To work out if a U/18 junior requires a permit as a result of playing matches in the SACA 1st grade competition, the following criteria will apply:
 - a. In respect to a player who has played 4 or more matches in the SACA 1st grade competition a permit will be required.
 - b. In granting a permit the association will consider how many ATCA junior games they have played. It will be the sole responsibility of the association in determining if the club has applied the spirit of cricket in qualifying players playing in the SACA 1st grade competition
 - c. Where any junior player is faced with the possibility of participating in a SACA match which clashes with the ATCA junior finals, such player can only represent one association on that day

3) D6 (b) EXCESSIVE HEAT - HEAT POLICY SENIOR COMPETITION

Add following clause to b) (iii) or expand on (ii)

- (iii) The decision to abandoned the competition at 42 degrees is solely the responsibility of the association. If play has commenced and the temperature exceeds 42 degrees the umpires have no authority to call off play.

4) D29. (13) ATCA TWENTY/20 PLAYING CONDITIONS.

Add following clause

- h) Any team that includes a player in contravention of this bylaw shall lose the match in which such a player takes part, as well as being subject to bylaw C2 (1) (b).

5) B10. MATCH REPORTS TO BE FURNISHED

Add timelines for T20 Comp

Home and Away Team Responsibilities

1. Selection of teams, individual player statistics and match results must be entered into MyCricket by midnight on the Friday following the completion of the match.

6) D4 – PLAYING HOURS ONE DAY MATCHES

- Change start time for B1 to C2 from 1.00pm to 12.30pm then same as A1 to A3

7) C2 – PERMIT FOR CLEARANCE SENIOR SECTION

Add following wording to clause C2 (d)

- Monies owed is only limited to membership and balls fees. Any clothing, player payments, etc will not be considered as monies owed.

8) C5. QUALIFICATIONS FOR SEMI-FINAL AND FINAL MATCHES**Add following wording to clause C5 (1) (3)**

- Clubs that have more than one bye in a season may include that game to meet the above qualification standards if the team list is entered into MyCricket by midnight on the **Wednesday** following the completion of the match.

9) B12 GRAND FINAL MATCHES - ALL GRADES**Delete the following clause B12 (e)**

If more than 30 minutes play is lost on the first day of a Final then By-Law D9 (1)(d) shall apply taking into account any scheduled finishing time as allowed by the Finals Special Conditions below.

10) D26 BOWLING OF DANGEROUS AND UNFAIR NON-PITCHING DELIVERIES**Change Bylaw heading as follows**

- Then need to reference Laws of Cricket 41.6 Bowling of dangerous and unfair short pitched deliveries applies
